Dear Lito,

Your concerns are valid.

Hence, Ferdie and I spoke this morning and came to a gentleman's' agreement in exceptions handling for some NGAP members that cannot be located due to the fact that NGAP online update is not 100% available. We arrived at the following agreements:

1. We will stick by the agreement:
 - a. that No available index results in Open class player assignment
 - b. Certifications from NGAP clubs showing index is accepted and processed
 - c. Certifications from NGAP clubs showing Handicaps ONLY is adjusted accordingly (minus 1 or 2 depending on agreed adjustments and as discussed in our meeting)
2. One of the challenges IPI has is accessing as many NGAP updated June (July -released) indexes. As I understand IPI is dependent on the timely update of IPI postings online. We agreed that: (Joey please take note)
 - a. If IPI is not able to download the latest June 2009 (July-released) Indices for a particular club, IPI should download even the MAY 2009 (June -released) NGAP indexes of that Club. We will accept these but will adjust indexes by 10%. Classification and Cangolf course handicap is computed thereafter.
 - b. IPI should request for override approval from the committee at every instance of exception. Approval is done by the opposing school at all times (i.e. Ferdie for Ateneo / Bobby – for La Salle)
 - c. The April 2009 NGAP Indexes (May-released) is not acceptable. Hence, the player would fall into condition 1.a above.
3. Re: Valley handicaps – I have requested Bong Vilchez to email the full Valley Index of members. I will forward it to Joey as soon as I receive it.

Lastly, it is very challenging to encompass all NGAP indexes due to the fact that they are not as updated as IPI in online postings. There are also some clubs that are no longer IPI or NGAP members as I understand. This is beyond our control but the above exceptions handling steps can be considered as best-efforts to regain some integrity for the tournament and weed out any unforeseen results.

Hope these measures address your concerns. Thank you.

Dear Joey,

Thank you for this email and the list of NGAP indices that you were able to download.

I would like take this opportunity to outline some of the concerns I raised during our telephone conversation this afternoon:

1. Valley Golf - They used to be Federation/IPI affiliated. They are in the list of NGAP indices that you were able to download. They may or may not be NGAP affiliated. May I suggest that IPI requests from Valley the list of their members' handicap indices as of July, in soft or hard copy. You may course your request to Mr. Bong Vilchez. He is aware of our tournament. Hopefully, he will accomodate this request. You may mention my name...if that will help.

2. Some popular NGAP affiliated golf courses are not on the list of what you were able to download (e.g. Cebu Country Club, Alta Vista, Marapara, the golf courses in Davao, Cagayan de Oro, to name some). Based on our conversation this afternoon, I understand that what you were unable to download are indices as of July '09. In other words, you may and you will try to download indices as of latest month that you may access. This "less than current" indices will then be presented to the representative of Ateneo and La Salle who will discuss and agree on how the same may be used for the tournament. For your info, by agreement with Mr. Iggy Clavecilla, Ateneo's representative is Mr. Bobby Ysip while La Salle will be represented by Mr. Ferdie Atendido.

May I suggest that Bobby Ysip, Ferdie Atendido and you meet on or before Wednesday to resolve the above as well as other matters. One that comes to mind is, when is a player considered without a handicap index and there eligible to play in the Open (System 36) Class. It is imperative that we do not disqualify a player through no fault of his. To be able to do this, we must anticipate possible "gray areas" and resolve the same before the tournament.

Please include Mr. Ferdie Atendido in future emails you will send related to the above.
