1	ELIGIBILITY	<p>Open to all alumni and students (of Jesuit/Christian Brothers schools) qualified by and conditional to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.1. Having graduated or completed at least TWO (2) years. 1.2. ONE (1) year residency for students. 1.3. Limited to amateur golfers only 																																													
2	RULES OF PLAY	<p>Play shall be governed by the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2.1. The Rules of Golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews; 2.2. The local rules of Canlubang Golf and Country Club as printed on its scorecards; 2.3. The tournament rules as specified in this handout, and; 2.4. Any announcement made prior to the start of the tournament. <p><i>All questions arising from the conduct of play will be referred to the rules committee, whose decision is deemed final.</i></p>																																													
3	REGISTRATION	<p>Deadline for submission of pre-registration forms and payment is on JUL. 27, 2009 (Monday).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3.1. Pre-registered/paid participants will be given priority to slots allocated based on the submission of entry forms and date of payment. 3.2. Walk-in participants will be entertained on a first come, first served basis and be subject to availability of slots. 3.3. On-course Registration opens at 6:00 am. 3.4. Players must complete the registration (on-course) procedure 30 minutes before their assigned course tee-times and must be on-deck and ready to tee-off at least 5 minutes before the scheduled shotgun starts. 3.5. Upon confirmation of payment, player may claim giveaway/raffle & lunch ticket. The scorecard indicating the player's name, school, computed handicap, course assignment and designated starting hole will be issued at the course desk. 3.6. All participants are required to accomplish/submit the handicap confirmation slip to ascertain class and course assignment. 3.7. Any refund due to cancellation will be subject to a 10% deduction from the entry fee. 3.8. Cancellations two days before the tournament date will no longer have the benefit of any refund. 																																													
4	PAIRINGS	<p>SHOTGUN START: (NORTH COURSE: 8:30 AM. and SOUTH COURSE: 8:00 AM.)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4.1. Preferred hole assignments for pre-registered/paid participants will be reserved and blocked off. 4.2. Player classification and the pairings sheet will be posted at the playing venue. Upon publication all processed information/data on entries and schedules will be strictly applied and enforced. 4.3. Rule 6-3: Time of starting and groups (R & A Rules Limited) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Time of starting - the player shall start at the time laid down by the committee. <p>NOTE: If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time . . . the penalty for failure to start on time is . . . two strokes at the first hole. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.</p> b. Groups - The competitor shall remain throughout the round in the group arranged by the committee unless the committee authorizes or ratifies a change. <i>Penalty for breach of rule 6-3b: disqualification</i> 																																													
5	FORMAT (Tees/Tee-off)	<p>INDIVIDUAL 18-HOLE STROKE PLAY</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5.1. All categories will be individual stroke play with handicaps applied. 5.2. All players, including seniors and ladies with no club certified handicap indexes will be categorized in the Open class. 5.4. Players 55 years & above with current certified handicap indexes may opt to play in the Seniors category. 5.5. Alumni 55 years old and above who do not specify their intention to play in the Seniors category when filling up the handicap verification form, will automatically be classified in the category where his handicap index falls. 5.6. 6	HANDICAPS	<p>The JUNE 2009 (released JULY 2009) USGA computed handicap index provided by IPI/NGAP will be used.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6.1. All participants are requested to submit/present their CLUB CERTIFIED HANDICAP INDEX CARD. 6.2. The slope rating of Canlubang's courses will be used to convert all submitted handicap indexes (rule 5.1 - table). 6.3. Players with multiple club membership must declare their lowest handicap index. Failure to comply may merit disqualification without benefit of refund. <p>To compute for your handicap (example):</p> $\frac{10.2 \text{ (handicap index)} \times 131 \text{ (north course slope rating: white tee)}}{113 \text{ (average slope rating)}} = 11.824 \text{ (rounded off to 12)}$ <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6.4. The Open class will be for players with no valid index and scoring shall be computed using the SYSTEM 36 handicapping. 6.5. SYSTEM 36 HANDICAPPING: A point is given for every bogey scored and two points for each par, birdie, eagle or hole-in-one made by the participant. The total/accumulated points will then be deducted from 36 and the difference becomes the player's handicap. The resulting handicap will then be subtracted from the Gross Score to get the player's Net Score.

7.1. The school that garners 50% plus one of the total points to be disputed will be declared the winner of the dual meet.

8 SCORING

Cross-scoring must be followed at all times.

SCORECARDS

- 8.1. Only gross scores must be reflected on the official scorecards preferably using ballpoint pens.
- 8.2. Players must sign their scorecard after ensuring that their marker has also signed the scorecard attesting to the correctness of the scores reflected therein.
- 8.3. Scorecards must be submitted within 15 minutes of holing-out otherwise the player's score will not count in the tournament.
- 8.4. Alterations/erasures in scores must be cleared/clarified before submission. All scores not legibly written will be subject to the committee's interpretation.
- 8.5. Caddies are not allowed to submit scorecards for players.

9 TIES

Rule on countback (R & A Rules Limited)

- 9.1. Ties will be broken in favor of the player with the better gross score in the back nine (holes #10 - #18). If still tied, reckoning will be from the last six (6) then three (3), and if still tied, counting backwards from hole #18.

10 TOURNAMENT FEE

PHP2,700.00 for non-Cangolf and PHP1,200.00 for Cangolf members

- 10.1. Caddy fee (minimum of P400) and golf cart rental (P800) will be on a personal account basis.
- 10.2. Due to limited availability of golf carts:
 - 10.2.1. Priority in rental of carts will be given to senior golfers and pre-registered/paid participants, after which, all others will be accommodated subject to availability.
 - 10.2.2. The golf cart may accommodate a maximum of three persons but without the golf bags (sets) in the rear carriage.
- 10.3. The tournament fee includes the green fee, a set of giveaways plus the lunch and raffle ticket/stubs.

12 HOLE-IN-ONE

For sponsored hole-in-one prizes, the following rules will apply:

- 12.1. In case there is more than one winner for the same prize (at stake in both courses), the winners will divide the prize equally.
- 12.2. Any and all taxes required will be for the account of the winner(s).
